You will need:

- A cross template

- Coffee Filter paper

You will need:

- A hard-boiled egg
- A paintbrush
- Paint



Easter Egg Doily

You will need:

- Paper doilies
- Washable felt tip pens
- A pot of water
- A paintbrush
- Coloured paper



Draw on the doily with felt tips

Wash over the doily with water

Cut out the egg shape onto coloured paper


