

#### WHAT IS PHONICS?

Each day the children have a 20 minute daily phonics lesson.

Children are taught to read by focussing on three essential skills: blending, segmenting and phoneme manipulation

#### WHAT IS PHONICS?

Segmenting is the process of breaking down words into individual sounds, such as: /c//a//t/.

Blending is the process of combining sounds together to read a word. For example: the word cat is made up of three sounds /c//a//t/. Blending is a very important skill for reading!

Phoneme Manipulation is simply changing individual phonemes (sounds) in a word. An example would be is a child was asked to change the /s/ in 'sat' to /b/ and we get 'bat'.

#### WHY DO WE TEACH PHONICS?

In 2006 there was an independent review of the teaching of early reading (The Rose Report) and they identified two main parts of reading: word recognition and language comprehension.

Comprehension is the <u>ultimate goal of reading</u> but this goal cannot be achieved unless children can recognise the words on the page.

Phonics is essential in the progression of early reading skills and to build on fluency and understanding.






#### EXTENDED CODE

In Year 2 the children continue through the Extended Code and begin focussing on polysyllabic words. (e.g. hay/stack, play/mate)


Whilst daily reading with your child is strongly encouraged to best support early reading skills, it is also 50 important to not forget about reading for pleasure!


This course introduces you to the Sounds-Write phonics programme, and gives you the knowledge, resources and activities you need to help your child to start learning to read and write.

The course is designed for parents and carers of children aged 4 to 6 who want to know how to get their children started in their journey towards becoming literate.


