Green	97% and above

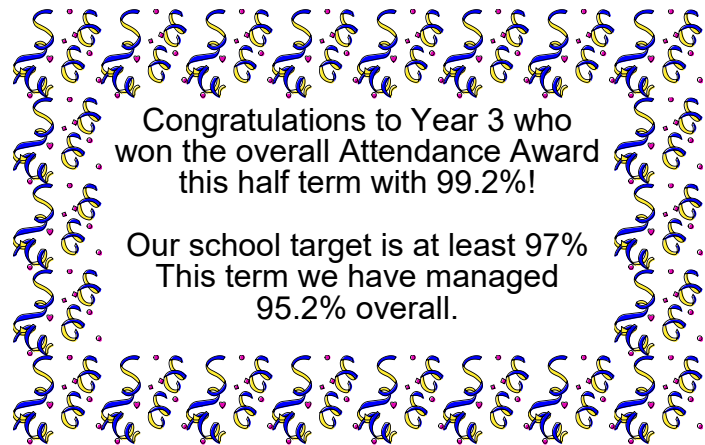
If your child is going to be absent, please inform the school office on 01915 367922 by 9am on **each morning** of the absence.
